Math Update:

- This week we continued working on adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers. One strategy we use a lot is an open number line. Since subtracting is finding the difference between two numbers, it is often easiest to add up using an open number line. The attached letter explains this strategy in more detail.
- Next week, we will shift our focus to geometric shapes: circle, triangle, square, rectangle, quadrilateral, pentagon, hexagon, trapezoid, octagon, rhombus/diamond, parallelogram, and cube). The names in bold are new for most 2nd graders.
